

**Criteria for Lakehead Unitarian Fellowship (LUF) Delegates
to Canadian Unitarian Council's Annual Conference and Meeting (CUC-ACM)
Held each year on Victoria Day weekend**

Applicants are advised to apply in writing to the President of the Fellowship before March 31. A brief outline confirming familiarity with the guidelines below is required. Notification of appointment will follow the April Board Meeting, prior to the CUC ACM.

Guidelines:

1. Applicant must be a member in good standing of the Lakehead Unitarian Fellowship.
2. Applicant will have knowledge of the affairs to be discussed at the CUC ACM.
3. Applicant must be willing to attend two meetings of the LUF congregation:
 - One meeting before the CUC ACM, to discuss the issues and get voting instructions, if any, from the congregation,
 - One meeting after the CUC ACM, to present a written report to the congregation at the LUF AGM
4. Delegates will be expected to vote according to the consensus of the LUF membership but can follow their conscience if further information and discussion at the CUC ACM opens other options.
5. LUF will pay the registration fees for Delegates.
6. Other related expenses, i.e., for all food, travel and accommodations, will be receipted by LUF, for an Income tax credit for the delegate, from original receipts submitted to the Fellowship.
